Holy Week (Veliki Tjedan)

We are entering the holies of seasons in the church remembering the sacred mysteries of the passion, death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. There are no events in the history of the world comparable with the Christ event. Nothing has ever and nothing ever will come even close to the magnitude of this. Therefore let us take time to remember and receive the love of God. Let us spend more time in prayer and fasting this week – gazing and the crucifix, meditate on the passion, listen to God, spend with the Word of God and fruitfully participate in the liturgies of the Holy Week.

During this time many people who do not attend the church regularly also come to join us for liturgies. We welcome all registered parishioners at St. Nicholas Tavelich to attend the liturgies of the Holy week. We can fit most of the people in the church proper but if the church reaches the capacity we will use the church hall where the liturgies will be live streamed. **There can be no intermingling of people from the church proper and those in the church hall at any one time.** Please use the washrooms on the level you are on. There will be someone outside to direct you to use separate entrance for the hall if the church is full.

Plan to arrive early.

PUBLIC MASSES: Currently the limit on church gatherings in the Province of Manitoba is 25% of church capacity or 100 people whichever is lower. For our church this means 82 people are allowed to gather at any one time for worship. For weddings, funerals and baptisms only 25 people can gather at one time. Therefore, feel free to come to mass and tell others from our community to do so. You will need to SIGN-IN (name and phone number) and put a checkmark beside your name upon arrival to the church OR *if you already registered previously put a checkmark beside your name.* This information is confidential and is stored for 21 days for contact tracing purposes.

We have changed the way we sanitize the pews: Upon entry to the church (before mass or other event) please take a wet wipe (located at each entrance) and sanitize the place where you will be sitting. Thank you.
